ORDER

Upon consideration of the lodged petition for a writ of mandamus and writ of prohibition, the emergency motion to stay the military commission proceedings, the motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis, and the motion to exceed the page limits, it is

ORDERED that the motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis be granted. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the motion to exceed the page limits be granted. The Clerk is directed to file the lodged petition for a writ of mandamus and writ of prohibition. It is

FURTHER ORDERED, on the court's own motion, that respondent file a response to the petition for a writ of mandamus and writ of prohibition and motion to stay the military commission proceedings, not to exceed 30 pages, by 12:00 noon on Tuesday, September 15, 2009. Petitioner's reply, not to exceed 15 pages, is due by 12:00 noon on Thursday, September 17, 2009. The parties are directed to file and serve the paper copies of their pleadings by hand.
