

ORDER

Upon consideration of the motion to stay military commission proceedings, the opposition thereto, and the reply, it is

ORDERED that the motion be denied without prejudice to renewal upon the Supreme Court's disposition in <u>Boumediene v. Bush</u>, No. 06-1195 (U.S. argued Dec. 5, 2007). Appellant has not demonstrated that the issuance of a stay pending <u>Boumediene</u> satisfies the requirements for the exercise of the court's authority pursuant to the All Writs Act. 28 U.S.C. § 1651; <u>see Belbacha v. Bush</u>, 520 F.3d 452 (D.C. Cir. 2008).
