Schuette v. Coal. to Defend Affirmative Action, Integration and Immigrant Rights and Fight for Equality By Any Means Necessary (BAMN), et al., No. 12-682

Dear Mr. Suter:

We represent certain respondents in the above-referenced matter. We write to the Court respectfully to request that the time for filing our clients' response to the certiorari petition be extended by thirty days to February 4, 2013, due to the press of other litigation deadlines. Although our clients, Respondents Chase Cantrell, et al., were listed in the petition for certiorari as "additional plaintiffs," we wish to clarify that, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 12.6, they are respondents in this case, and we respectfully ask that the caption be modified accordingly. The petition for certiorari seeks review of the Sixth Circuit's en banc judgment in *Coal. to Defend Affirmative Action, Integration and Immigrant Rights and Fight for Equality By Any Means Necessary (BAMN) v. Regents of the University of Michigan*, Nos. 08-1387, 08-1389, 08-1534, 09-1111, __ F.3d __, 2012 WL 5519918 (6th Cir. Nov. 15, 2012), resolving appellate proceedings in two cases involving two separate sets of plaintiffs that were consolidated by the district court.
