-  Requires each physician who performs an abortion to have privileges, substantially similar to Texas
-  Requires physician with privileges to be on premises for procedure
-  Requires provider to at least have agreement with separate physician/hospital to provide privileges
-  Requires provider to either have privileges or have transfer agreement with hospital
