Upon consideration of the petition for a writ of mandamus and writ of prohibition and the motion for a stay, the opposition thereto, and the reply; and the letters filed pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 28(j), it is

**ORDERED**, on the court's own motion, that the parties file status reports within 72 hours of the military commission's disposition of the pending request for a 60-day continuance of all proceedings. The status reports should address how the military commission's disposition of that request affects the pending petition and motion for a stay. The parties are reminded to update the court promptly regarding any developments that may affect the disposition of this case.
